WHO MAY APPLY: Women who have not previously received an AAUW scholarship and have been residents for at least two years of the following towns: Bridgeport, Easton, Fairfield, Monroe, Newtown, Shelton, Stratford, or Trumbull. Women of all ages may request applications. Applicants must attend an accredited community college, college, or university. Each applicant must have completed 30 credits by June 2010 and must be continuing their program of study for the school year 2010-11.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE: Students enrolled in degree programs, certification programs, or special courses designed to upgrade professional competencies.

HOW AWARDS ARE DETERMINED: Scholarships are based on a student's need, academic performance, and personal qualifications. A student who applies for these awards must be available for a personal interview, if requested.
